A structured employment-focused program for young adults with autism spectrum disorder



The Learning Academy at Drexel University, is anticipated to start in September 2019.

Transition Pathways of the A.J. Drexel Autism Institute plans to replicate this 30-week transition program from the University of South Florida. The Learning Academy provides services, supports and experiential opportunities for participants to develop and achieve employment goals and enhance independence.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Between 18-25 years of age
- Have a diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder
- Can travel independently or has the willingness be trained to travel independently
- Has a goal of employment and career development
- Can commit to completing a 30 week program, averaging 20 hours a week
- Has demonstrated the ability to regulate their behavior with minimal direction
- Eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation Services

AT THE END OF THE PROGRAM STUDENTS WILL HAVE:

- ✓ An electronic portfolio describing who they are, their strengths and their goals
- ✓ A newly designed resume
- ✓ A clearly developed plan for the future including job and/or college seeking skills
- ✓ Completed a paid internship
- ✓ A certificate of completion from The Learning Academy at Drexel University
